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## Coiled Beaded Bracelet Wires

You will so enjoy these fun and versatile bracelet wires!

Use your imagination, use different beads, shapes, sizes and make coils of all sorts and colors to enjoy!

Measure your wrist with a string, then measure the string for length of bracelet. Add 6 inches.

If your wrist is 6 inches around, then you need 3 inches additional on either side for making the loops, so 12 inches total.

Start with one length of 20 gauge round wire, enough inches long for comfort.

Use flat and nylon jaw pliers to straighten the wire. Stroke it with the nylon jaws, 5-6 times (this will harden it slightly also).

Use round nose pliers and make a 90 degree bend 3 inches in from the end of the wire. Image 2

Go deep into the round nose plier, making a large loop. Bring the wire end straight down. Image 3

Loosen your grip on the plier and rotate the plier tooth off the neck of the loop and regrip on the top of the looped wire. Image 4-5

Bring the short wire back to the 'front' making a complete loop around the bottom plier tooth, bringing it perpendicular to the longer wire length. Image 6

Perfectly Twisted Jewelry Coiled

Take the short wire end and make 3 tight wraps around the neck of the longer wire just below the plier teeth. Wrap closes to the plier, moving away from it and down the longer wire. Image 7-10 -Close up

Use flush cutters to trim the short wire end and flat or chain link pliers to tap the cut end if needed. Image 11-12-13

## **Adding Coils and Beads**

Average women wrists are 6-8 inches. Average men wrists are 8-10 inches.

Add beads and coils of your choosing to the 20g wire. Image 14 Leave 3 inches of bare wire to create the closing loop.

After beads and coils are on the wire, use round nose pliers, grab the wire deep into the wide part of the plier and just above the last bead or coil (2-3mm). Image 15.

Make a 90 degree bend in the wire. Image 16. Bring the wire end over the top of the plier to begin forming the loop. Image 17

Rotate the plier head off of the beaded neck and regrip on top of the looped wire. Bring the wire end back to the front of the plier to form a complete loop around the plier tooth. Image 18-Close up

Make 3 tight wraps around the beaded wire neck, just below the plier and wrap moving from the plier, toward the beads. Image 19-20

Use flush cutters to trim away the excess wire end and flat or chain link pliers to tap the cut end neat and clean if needed. Image 21

Form the bracelet wire around a dowel (PVC pipe from the Home Depot or local hardware store, a coffee, measuring cup, etc of appropriate wrist size). Image 22

Shape the bracelet around your wrist and determine how large the clasp needs to be ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{3}{4}$  to 1 inch for comfort, should be the gap). Image 23 - Close up

Make many of these and stack your gorgeous bracelet cuffs!

Read on and learn to use 3 inches of 20g wire to create the bracelet hook. Enjoy!!

Use 3 inches of 20g round wire to create your own bracelet hooks!

Use round nose pliers and create a small loop at one of the wire ends. Then grab the wire at ½, ¾ or 1 inch below the loop. Image 25

Create a deep bend moving opposite of the loop. Bring the loop and wire ends 'almost' together and then create a slight upward turn in the unlooped wire end. Image 26

Cut away the end approximately 'even' with the looped end. Use the tip of your round nose plier and turn the cut end slightly upward. Image 27-28

Hammer the curved top of the hook and the closed loop for hardening.

Bend the loop sideways, insert one end of the bracelet loops and close the hook loop.


